

Workman Township
Wednesday, June 24th Meeting starting at 4 pm.
Palisade Community Center/Firehall

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Berg followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. All members were in attendance with 1 citizen attending. Motion was made by Holsten with second by Kamrowski to approve the agenda. Motion carried (3-0).

Clerk Essen read the May Minutes. Motion to approve by Kamrowski with second by Holsten. Motion carried (3-0). Minutes of a Special Meeting was read with motion to approve by Holsten and second by Kamrowski. Motion carried (3-0). Treasurer Berg gave the treasurer's report. Motion to accept was made by Holsten with second by Kamrowski (3-0). Clerk and Treasurer amounts balanced.

Supervisor Holsten reported that the buildings, fire, first responders action was unchanged except that at the next meeting a discussion should be made on the Workman Town Hall building and furniture/fixtures. Cemetery report by Supervisor Kamrowski showed a strong attendance at the cemetery to hear patriotic music and observe the American Legion and VFW conduct their ceremony over a veteran's grave on Memorial Day. We will be starting on our 4th year in 2020 and are making plans for an even larger event. A motion to approve joining the Minnesota Cemetery Association was made by Kamrowski, second by Holsten. Motion passed (3-0). Discussion should be made at the next meeting regarding watering issues, shrub and tree replacement along with locating the cement markers in the cemetery. Supervisor Berg reported on the grader, snowplow truck and condition of the roads and culverts. Everything is going along with no serious problems. Motion to use the snowplow and/or grader on only Workman Township roads was made by Holsten with a second by Kamrowski. Motion carried (3-0).

Clerk Essen read the claims and after some discussion, motion to approve was made by Holsten with second by Kamrowski. Motion carried (3-0).

No correspondence was received. Discussion on how much and when funds from FEMA should be transferred from checking to saving was made. This will be tabled until our next meeting. Brush cutting by Hansen and also by Turner Township (mainly on Grouse Street) will be done in the next 30 days.

Clerk Essen and Treasurer Berg will be attending MAT training- mainly for CTAS – on Wednesday, June 26th at Breezy Point.

Next monthly meeting will be held at 4 pm on Wednesday, July 17th
