

Workman Township
Monthly meeting July 17, at 4pm
Palisade Community Center/Firehall

The July monthly meeting was called to order at 4 pm by Chairman Berg with all officers in attendance and one citizen. Motion to approve the Agenda was made by Holsten with second by Kamrowski. Motion approved, (3-0) Clerk Essen read the June minutes with motion to approve by Kamrowski and second by Holsten. The minutes will stand as read. Treasurer Betty Berg gave her report which was approved by Holsten with a second by Kamrowski. Motion carried (3-0) The treasurer and clerk records balance.

Supervisor Holsten reported on buildings, fire, first responders. No action was necessary. The town hall in the township is being maintained. No reports of fire or actions by first responders.

Supervisor Kamrowski reported on Lakeview Cemetery. Several new replacement trees have been added and several more need to be added. Motion to add a water pumping system was made by Kamrowski with second by Holsten. Estimated cost is approximately \$600.00. Motion carried (3-0) Joining the Minnesota Cemetery Association should allow better management of our cemetery. Several concrete markers have been unearthed at the cemetery. There will be an additional attempt to find more.

Supervisor Berg reported on the grader and newly purchased used snowplow which is undergoing some maintenance and upgrading. The work is not going as quickly as first planned. Grader is being used for basic road grading and appears to be working without problems. Additional gravel will be needed on Grouse and 240 and 241. Meeting with Darlow resulted in Darlow agreeing to be backup for snowplowing along with Kern Excavating. We are still looking for a class a or b CDL operator. Ads have been placed in our two newspapers along with flyers being posted at various businesses.

Clerk Essen read the claims. After a brief discussion a motion was made by Holsten with second by Kamrowski to pay the claims. Motion carried (3-0).

No correspondence received.

Betty and Wanda attended the MAT training at Breezy Point but were disappointed in the time allotted. A general discussion was made concerning placing funds in savings. Agreement was that we should wait until November when the second part of our levy is received.

Various paperwork was signed and completed by those involved. Next meeting set for August 21st at 4 pm

Supervisor Kamrowski made motion to adjourn at 5:25 with second by Holsten. Motion carried (3-0).
