The Workman Township monthly meeting was opened at 4 pm by Chairman Berg with all Board present. No citizens or guests were present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of The United States of American was recited by the Board.

The Aitkin County Highway Department has been contacted to use their specialized equipment to remove ice on several township roads, This was followed by applying sand/salt mixture from our plowtruck. The County Engineer called concerning work on County Road 3 and the intersection with 241st Place when work continues on Cty 3 this summer. Gary Wilke will again operate our grader this summer. Additional road information will be in the road report at the township annual meeting.

Reading of claims to be paid was made By Clerk Essen and after discussion motion to pay was made by Kamrowski with second by Holsten. Motion carried. (3-0) Board of Audit was made with all supervisors individually checking claims and checks. Everything was in order. Discussion on levy proposal for annual meeting was made with recommendation to maintain levy at \$84,000. Motion by Kamrowski and second by Holsten to maintain current levy. Motion carried, (3-0) Motion to maintain board life insurance policy the same as previous year by Kamrowski with second by Holsten, Motion carried, (3-0) No additional business was discussed.

Annual Meeting is at 9 am on Tuesday, March 10th with alternate bad weather day March 17th. Next meeting set for March 18th at 4 pm. Necessary paperwork completed and checks signed. Motion to adjourn at 5:35 pm by Kamrowski with second by Holsten, Motion carried. (3-0)
