

Workman Township Monthly Meeting
4pm, Wednesday, July 15, 2020

The Workman Township Monthly Meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Berg at 4pm. All board members were in attendance except for Supervisor Fred Kamrowski who arrived at 4:30 pm. No citizens or guests were in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was recited by members present.

Motion to accept the Agenda was made by Supervisor Marv Holsten with second by Chairman Berg. Motion carried (2-0).

Workman Township board minutes for July was read by Clerk Wanda Essen. Motion to accept the minutes was made by Supervisor Marv Holsten with second by Chairman Jim Berg. Motion carried (2-0). The treasurer report was made by Treasurer Betty Berg. Treasurer money account and clerk money account balance. Motion to approve by Supervisor Holsten with second by Chairman Berg. Motion carried (2-0). Motion for Treasurer Berg to locate our 3-year Certificate of Deposit at a local area bank or credit union having the highest interest rate by Supervisor Holsten with second by Supervisor Kamrowski. Motion carried (3-0).

Supervisor Holsten reported on buildings, fire/first responders. Two solar lights were placed - one by the front entrance of the township hall and one by the entrance to the grader garage. They appear to be working fine.

Supervisor Kamrowski reported on Lakeview Cemetery. New hire Tom (HS senior) is doing a fine job of watering the bushes, flowers, and trees. Snow fence will be built along south end of cemetery.

Chairman Berg reported on roads and equipment. Both Kern and Fredrickson have applied class 5 on selected roads. Signs have been ordered for 280th, 285th, and 240th. Signs will be installed upon arrival.

New business included receipt of \$5,075 from the federal government to combat Covid 19. Approval must be given by the federal government on the use of the funds. We are awaiting a letter of approval.

Reading of claims to be paid was read by Clerk Essen. After discussion, approval to pay was made by Supervisor Holsten with second by Supervisor Kamrowski. Motion carried (3-0).

Necessary paperwork and checks were signed. Next monthly meeting will be Wednesday, August 19th. Motion to adjourn was made by Supervisor Kamrowski with second by Supervisor Holsten. Motion carried (3-0). Meeting was adjourned at 5:19 pm.
