

Workman Township Monthly Meeting  
Wednesday, November 18, 2020, 4 pm  
Palisade Community Center/Firehall

The Workman Township Monthly Meeting was called to order at 4 pm by Chairman Jim Berg with all board members present. No citizens or visitors were in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was recited by the board members. After some adjustments were made to the Agenda Supervisor Holsten moved to approve the agenda with a second by Supervisor Kamrowski. Motion carried 3-0.

Workman Township October Minutes were read by Clerk Wanda Essen. Motion to approve the Minutes was made by Supervisor Kamrowski with a second by Supervisor Holsten Motion carried 3-0.

Workman Township Treasurer Report was presented by Treasurer Betty Berg. Clerk and Treasurer account balances agree. Motion to accept the Treasurer Report was made by Supervisor Holsten with second by Supervisor Kamrowki.

Supervisor Holsten gave a report on buildings and fire/first responders. Phone call from the Palisade Fire Department Chief indicates they are requesting a 5% increase in their fire billing.

Supervisor Kamrowski reported on Lakeview Cemetery which included spraying of trees and bushes with antideer spray to protect the trees and bushes from deer over the winter. The Minnesota Cemetery Association has sent several emails regarding Covid 19 and practices at cemeteries.

Supervisor Berg reported on roads and equipment. The report on the road review conducted by the supervisors on October 20<sup>th</sup> was reviewed. There was general agreement that the roads are steadily improving but constant effort is needed to show improvement. Equipment is satisfactory. We are waiting on a part for the auger for our snowplow.

Motion was made to turn the \$5,075 Covid 19 funds over to Aitkin County. Motion by Holsten and second by Kamrowski to send the funds to Aitkin County. Motion carried 3-0.

Storage for snowplow was discussed with Supervisor Holsten stating he would rent a space to the township for one year for \$600 (\$50.00) per month. Supervisor Holsten recused himself from further discussion on the rental citing Minnesota Township rules. After discussion with Supervisor Kamrowski and Supervisor Berg, Supervisor Kamrowski made a motion to issued a check for \$600 to Holsten for one year rental starting November 1,2020. Second by Supervisor Berg. Motion carried 2-0 with Supervisor Holsten abstaining.

Monthly claims were read and after review and discussion Supervisor Kamrowski made a motion to approve with a second by Supervisor Holsten. Motion carried 3-0.

Calendar was reviewed for upcoming training and next meeting was set for November 18<sup>th</sup>. Paperwork requiring signatures was signed. Supervisor Kamrowski made a motion to adjourn at 5:11 with second by Supervisor Holsten. Motion carried 3-0.
